

Rail movement impacted from North India ICD's to Mundra & Pipavav due to derailment in Ajmer division**Customer Advisory # MUM/2018-19/082**

Dear Valued Customers,

We regret to inform you that a goods train derailed between Abu Road & Maval in Ajmer division (NW Railway) on 24th July'2018. As such, the train movement on and via Ajmer and adjacent divisions is adversely affected.

Most of the trains of all train operators which were supposed to move via said route have been stabled in Jaipur, Ajmer & Ahmedabad division.

Rail movements from North India ICD's to Mundra and Pipavav have been impacted due to the unfortunate incident.

These en-route disruptions are impacting the transit as well as Import/Export evacuation from Ports & ICD's respectively.

Further because of the heavy rain in Rajasthan, breaches are also reported on Railway route in Jaipur Division due to which train movement is also sluggish.

As on today Indian Railways has opened up the track but priority is being given to passenger trains. We are expecting the track to be opened for cargo trains by tonight.

We shall keep you posted if any further updates available.
