Dear Valued Customers,

Please be advise that IMD has issued cyclone warning for Maharashtra and Gujarat coast. The Cyclonic Storm "Nisarga" is expected to make land fall tomorrow in North Maharashtra & South Gujarat coasts. Therefore ports & terminals situated on these coasts have taken appropriate measures to deal with the situation as mentioned below.

Nhava Sheva: -

- Port will be evacuating all the vessels, depending upon the situation, from all the berths to outer anchorage.
- No marine movements on 3rd June 2020 till the situation gets back to normal.
- PS3 service MOL Maestro eta 04th June 2020 @ 0830 hrs, expected to be delayed by 24-48 hrs, depending upon berthing prospects for earlier vessels.

Pipavav: -

- APMT Pipavav has also issued Cyclonic warning and if required all the vessels at berth will be shifted to outer anchorage prior June 3rd.
- Since no ONE vessel will be at Pipavav during this period, no impact to our vessel.

We will keep you posted on further information received from the Terminal.
