



Extremely Severe Weather Conditions – Mundra – Gujarat Coast

Dear Valued Customers,

Mundra Port is currently facing significant challenges due to severe weather and ongoing congestion issues.

Heavy rainfall in Gujarat has led to flooding and waterlogging, which has heavily impacted operations at Mundra Port. The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a "Red Alert" warning. This situation is further complicated by the disruption in cargo rail movement due to flooding in the Saurashtra region.

The combined impact of weather and congestion is likely to cause delays and disruptions for both inbound and outbound shipments in the coming days.

Request to take note of the current Vessel berthing situation.

MV Hyundai Busan V 002 - Berthed on 28th August – Shifted to Anchorage due to adverse weather conditions.

MV Norderney V 0087 & MV Seattle Bridge V 0091 – Expected to berth on 29th August – Still not berthed due to adverse weather conditions.

We regret the Inconvenience caused due to the delays and will keep you informed as and when we receive an update.
